

## Evidence based data from W&KPC survey of Netball Clubs. November 2023

### Participants:

Knowle Hotshots

Ravens

### Methodology

1. A survey was drafted, and advice sought, from Carey McCormick, Netball Development Officer, Hampshire & Isle of Wight, England Netball
2. The survey was made available via an online Google Forms format and tested for functionality by non-participants
3. Requests to complete the survey were sent to Clubs via email from the Netball Development Officer
4. An individual invitation to participate was sent to Knowle Hotshots because that Club is not a registered member of Netball England, even though they play matches the "All about Netball" local league.
5. The survey closed in early November and the raw data is tabulated in the report below.

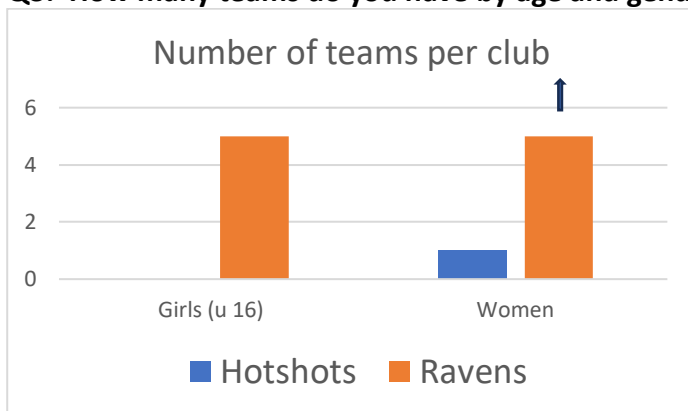
### RESPONSES

Hotshots: Knowle

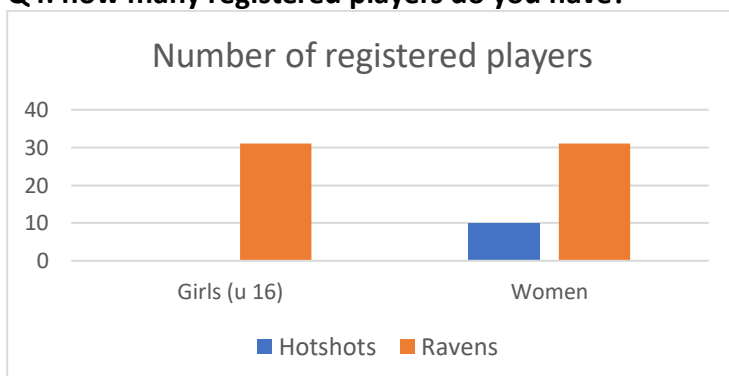
Ravens: Eastleigh
