Wickham Community Tennis Club (WCTC)

Survey among Club members October 2023

Introduction

Wickham & Knowle parish has been provided with the opportunity to instal sports facilities at a new site in Mill Lane, Wickham.

The potential for possible inclusion of racquet sports needed exploration as an update and adjunct to a survey conducted among members in 2021.

Background

A final community-wide survey of options for the Mill Lane site is planned to take place in the autumn of this year (note: now delayed in Q1 2024)

In the past 12 months a Forum of "stakeholders" has been debating possible facilities and these were presented to the Council in March 2023.

Purpose of Survey

To ensure that residents are provided with accurate and useful information in the final survey, the Council wishes to obtain quantifiable and up to date views of certain interest groups regarding some of the facilities that have been proposed in the Forum.

This questionnaire has been designed for completion only by members of WCTC.

Survey details

Methodology

- 1. The questionnaire was discussed with and approved by the Chair of WCTC.
- 2. The survey was transferred into a Google form by John Ridge and made accessible to members via email from the Chair. Paper copies were available if requested (none were).
- 3. Responses were recorded and analysed by John Ridge
- 4. A set of main findings was discussed and agreed between the Chair of WCTC, John Ridge and Nic Holladay (Chair of W&KPC Recreation Committee)

Response rate:

A link to the survey form was sent by email to the 67 WCTC members who had given their permission to the Club to receive emails.

A total of 39 responses were received

Response rate = 58% of those signed up to receive news emails from the Club. The club has 122 members across all ages and genders ,so responses were received from 32% of all members. Demographic profiles of respondents was also collected and further analysis by sub-group may be made and released in a later report update.

Main findings



- negative support in RED %

















JUNIOR TENNIS FACILITY

Q: Would you support reservation of space for courts at Mill Lane? R: 85% agree/strongly agree

Q: Would you support provision for junior tennis at Mill Lane?

R: 82% agree/strongly agree.

Respondents were also asked:

at which site do you think junior tennis provision should be provided: 46% had no preference; 33% preferred Mill Lane and 21% the Rec

Q: Do you think that provision of a tennis wall would be popular?

R: 72% agree/strongly agree (note: in 2021 score was 57%).

Respondents were also asked:

at which site they would prefer to see a tennis wall installed: a small majority had no preference (41%) but 38% favoured the Rec and 21% Mill Lane

Q: Do you think that provision of padel courts would be popular?

R: 67% agree/strongly agree (note: in 2021 score was 24%).

Respondents were also asked:

at which site they would prefer to see padel courts installed: the majority (54%) had no preference; 26% preferred Mill Lane; 21% preferred the Rec; would they prefer more than two courts in the first instance – one was favoured in the first instance: only 21% agreed/strongly agreed

Q: Would you like to see additional courts installed in an early phase of the development at Mill Lane rather than later?

R: 51% agree/strongly agree

Q: Do you think that provision for pickleball would be popular?

R: 46% agree/strongly agree

Preliminary conclusions (subject to financial feasibility study)

- 1. Space should be reserved at Mill Lane for future tennis provision
- 2. Padel should be incorporated in to the facilities plan if financially viable. This could be at The Rec or Mill Lane
- 3. A tennis wall should be provided if costs allow (and if at the Rec agreed by Rookesbury Estate)
- 4. Junior tennis provision at Mill Lane should be supported (possibly in multi-sports "court")
